Give or Take Days are like a jumble sale but without the money! Local people bring along unwanted but usable items, other residents then have the chance to browse and take away items they do want.

You don't have to give anything to take something new away or vice versa. Ultimately the events encourage reuse of items that would have otherwise ended up in landfill.

Donated items include kitchen gadgets, books, DVD, clothes, children's toys, general bric-a-brac and many more. Click here for a Yes Please, No Thanks List of what you can offer.

Any electrical items are tested for safety by experts on the day before being allowed to be passed on to potential new owners. Everything else is taken on at the new owner's risk.

Usually the recycling team are on hand to offer general waste and recycling advice. Also Freecycle often come along to advise on reusing and finding new homes for unwanted items.



Connect 2011 is a five-day teaching and worship event where hundreds of people of all ages can connect and grow together in Word and Spirit. There will be a full programme of teaching and worship over the 5 days but from the Friday evening on there will be a change in flavour as we welcome an influx of families and children.

The theme for the summer is *"Getting into Gear"* and Rev Dr Russ Parker is heading up a team of speakers. Everything on the programme is at this stage in pencil but, for your diary, we plan to begin with a celebration on Wednesday evening, 13th July and end around 5pm on Sunday 17th.

The family weekend (July 15, 16, 17) will include a full programme of children's activities in their own separate marquee, a chill out zone on Saturday evening for 13's to 17's plus a variety of fun family events throughout the weekend. Connect 2011 welcomes day visitors to the site as well as those who wish to camp for all or part of the time.

More than 30 south Dorset churches are involved in organising the event, which is held at Holton Lee (between Poole and Wareham in Dorset), just a few minutes walk from the beautiful Poole Harbour and with its own stunning heathland walks in 350 acres
