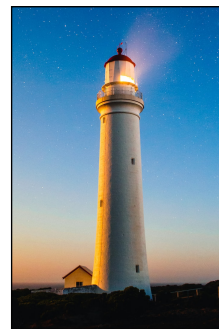

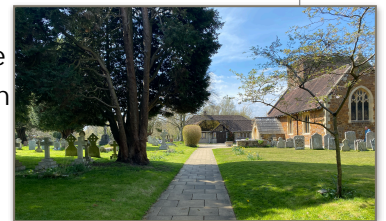

St Andrew's believe that prayer is vital for all that we do and believe we ought to support each others needs as they arise.

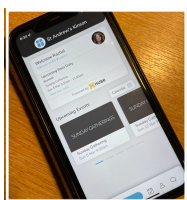
